One of the really big highlights of our ministry since returning to the field is **the salvation of Lety Flores!**

Lety is the wife of retired General Jorge Flores, who was saved under our ministry about 8 years ago. Many of you will remember his testimony at the end of our report video that we showed in the churches during our furlough time. Ever since Bro. Flores got saved, we have been praying for his wife, Lety, to be saved also. She has only attended our church once in the last 8 years! My wife and I, as well as several others, have witnessed to her on numerous occasions, but she just would not surrender to the Lord. It has been a real burden for Bro. Flores.



God brought several situations into her life, including the recent death of her Christian mother. Beth went one Tuesday to talk and witnessed to her for an hour and a half, but she still would not make a decision for Christ. The following Sunday she came to church and during the invitation raised her hand for salvation. My wife dealt with her, and **Lety was gloriously saved! I don't think there was a dry eye in the church that morning.** Since then, Lety has faithfully come to services on Sunday mornings and Bro. Flores says he has not seen her smile so much in years. For the last two weeks their grown daughter Nancy (who is not yet saved) has been attending with them. Please rejoice with us over Lety's decision and pray for Nancy's salvation as well.
