I would like to thank each of you who faithfully pray for the ministry here in Guatemala. This year has been especially challenging time-wise. Each week I have been teaching six different Bible Institute classes, plus the regular preaching responsibilities at the church. In the last several months, we have been very busy with many additional ministry opportunities other than "the usual."

JULY - I traveled to Cara Sucia (Dirty Face), El Salvador to teach and abbreviated, two-day seminar on Godly music titled "Make a Joyful Noise." (The seminar can be taught for anywhere from two hours to twelve hours depending on the time and needs of the church.)

AUGUST - I preached a "Family Day" at a sister church in Amatitlán, about an hour away. Two ladies received **Christ** as their Savior that evening.

The following week, I preached a two-day Marriage seminar at our second church, Abundant Life Baptist Church. They had good attendance and the brethren there made many decisions regarding their marriage life.

The last Sunday of the month, all three of the churches we have started got together for the dedication of the church building for Life in Him Baptist Church. The first church has gone through many struggles and setbacks over the years, but we praise the Lord for the stability and growth that is beginning to take place in their new location in San Luis Ayampuc. I sang and preached



the building dedication service that afternoon. **One young lady** got saved after the services.

SEPTEMBER – I recently had the privilege of preaching a three-night youth conference titled "Who Am I Going To Marry?" There were young people from at least nine different churches present with a high attendance on Saturday of over 130 young people. Each night the altar was full of teenagers making decisions in their lives regarding purity and seeking God's will for a life partner. Through it all, God has given the strength and grace to be able to preach and teach His Word in all of these opportunities. Thank you so much for your prayers!
