The above phrase appears on t-shirt after t-shirt in the souvenir market in downtown Guatemala City. It is a funny reminder for the thoughtful tourist that the desire to learn English in third-world countries is present-albeit seriously misspelled! ⁽²⁾



Knowing that desire became one of the focal points for the Guatemala Outreach Team ("GO Team" for short)—a wonderful team of 9 students and teachers from Pensacola Christian College, organized by Andrew Bowden and Cristina Lott, our daughter. We also had two young ladies from our church tag along as translators.



For 2 weeks in August, the GO Team ministered in diverse ways, sharing the Gospel with children and families, many of whom had not heard a clear message of the gift of salvation before. The first week they ministered at Life in Him Baptist Church (our first church) and the second week at Peniel Baptist Church (a sister church about

45 minutes east of Guatemala City.

For two hours each morning, medical workshops on pre/postnatal care, first aid, wound care, and other related nutrition, and consults with the nurse, along with a oneon-one Gospel presentation each patient who to attended. The rest of the team taught and played games with the children who came.



Each afternoon, the whole team participated in EASY **ENGLISH**—classes skillfully designed to teach beginning English, with an emphasis on Bible verses, including memorizing the verses in English, as well as Spanish.

The morning classes were not well attended, but the afternoon English classes were a HUGE SUCCESS! At the first church, we had an average attendance of more than 50 grade school aged children attending, with several mothers and fathers also attending. At the second church, the average was



over 150 kids each day! Praise the Lord!

On the Sunday, our church here (Truth Baptist Church) held a "Friend Day" with a good number of visitors, a meal and games for the kids and young people following.
