The first Sunday of February was the 7th anniversary of Truth Baptist Church. We had 81 in attendance! - a record for a service in which no other Baptist church was invited. We had special music by a guitar/violin duo, and I preached a message on what saving faith really is. Just

Due to a last minute cancelation by a national pastor, and with only about 4 days advance notice, we quickly put together the medical/ vision outreach in four different churches in the

greater Guatemala City area.

Bro. Bradley Edmondson (the director), Dr. Greg Waller (D.O.) and Bro. Bob Landeck (EMT) were our guests for a very busy and blessed week of ministry. **Beth** worked taking



vital signs and coordinating the flow of patients. Cristina and Rebekah worked hard all day every day translating for the team and learning about medical missions.

From 8AM until 6PM each day, patients were examined, treated, prescribed medications, provided eye glasses, and witnessed to one-on-one by national Christians. By the end of the week, the team of 3 had treated a total of 698



patients. Of those, 97 trusted the Lord as their personal Savior! Names and addresses of all 698 patients were then given to the national pastors for follow-up.

The opportunity to work

with several different Baptist churches was especially a blessing, and the pastor's have already reported new visitors to their churches since MMO's efforts. (Page 1 of 2)
