Appliances have already been purchased and delivered. What is happening right now is a HUGE answer to prayer! Praise the Lord with us!

UPDATE ON WALL PROJECT

We are happy to report that much of the needed funds for the special need for a retaining wall for Life in Him Baptist Church has been met. We have received \$6600.00 of the estimated \$7,000.00 that is the projected cost of the wall.

Yesterday at the church, we met with another Christian man who is familiar with the type of work needed, and he confirmed that it will take that amount or possibly a bit more to get the wall built to prevent further "cave-ins" of the surrounding mountain. Lord willing the construction of the wall will start next week!

THE PROCESS BEGINS!

We have officially started the "serious" task of selling things (vehicles, appliances, etc.), packing boxes and preparing for the shipping (furniture, dishes, books, etc.) for our move to Peru. Since Peru uses 220v instead of 110v, we will have to replace all major appliances in country (refrigerator, stove, washing machine, etc.).

Some have asked about the moving costs. Between flights, shipping and importation, and replacing of some items, we estimate the additional costs to be \$8,000.00-\$10,000.00. Please pray that the Lord will provide the needed funds.

Pray especially regarding a place to rent. Rental houses where we are planning to live are very scarce. Please pray that the Lord will provide the exact house for our new ministry in Peru. We look forward to what the Lord has in store for us!
