URGENT FINANCIAL NEED!

We praise the Lord for the direction, timing and wisdom He gives, especially when it avoids unnecessary spending!

In November of last year, we reported on the acquisition of land for the **Central Jungle Bible College (CJBC)**, for the purpose of housing dorm students and providing them with an environment for their theological and practical ministry

studies. We had a need at that time for raising money for the first phase of the building project. Several responded and that need was met, but now we have an urgent financial need, that we did not anticipate at that time.

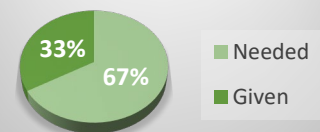
The rainy season in Peru is from January through April. Due to the heavy rains, we decided to not begin building until after the rains had ceased, and boy are we glad we did!

While we did our best to check out any possible problems with the land (including water supply, electricity, etc.), we did not anticipate **the numerous landslides on the road going to the property**. While the land is still very useful for the students to plant crops and work on, it is very impractical for anyone living on-site. The landslides this year made the road impassable for days at a time on several occasions.

We have found another piece of land not far away that is flatter, safer and more accessible on which to build the dorms and classrooms for the college. We would like to be able to purchase this as soon as possible (**June/July**) to start the construction and take advantage of the dry season. It is about 7 acres just off the main road, and costs around **\$30,000.00**. **We are asking that you pray about your part in this need**. We have already received \$10,000.00 towards this need, for which we are very grateful! However, more is needed... **Will you help us reach this goal?** Maybe you could "adopt" part of this land as a project for your church?

- 1 acre = \$4280.00
- 1/2 acre = \$2140.00
- 1/4 acre = \$1070.00
- 1/8 acre = \$ 535.00
