We praise the Lord for each student and for the growth in the Bible College, but it does cause us to depend more each day on His Grace in fulfilling all the ministry needs and responsibilities.

MINISTRY IN GUATEMALA

It has been over five years since we visited the brethren in Guatemala, where we ministered for over 27 years!

In 2001, I started an annual week-long Pastor's Camp for helping national pastors in their ministries and for developing a closer bond among the pastors in Guatemala

and the surrounding countries. The pastors that are now in charge of that ministry asked me to speak at the camp this year, which I gladly agreed to do.

The theme of this year's camp was "We Are At War!" with the focus being on spiritual warfare, especially as it pertains to the pastor's personal life, his family life and the ministry.

There were 100 pastors and lay ministers in attendance at this year's
